

Rochlow C.E.(Charles) Chief Warrant Officer



CWO Rochlow was born and raised in the Vancouver lower mainland. He is a graduate of Baden Senior Secondary School (Germany).

CWO Rochlow, joined the Canadian Armed Forces in Sept 1983, as an Infanteer with the PPCLI, after basic training in Wainwright AB, he was posted to 3 PPCLI in Victoria BC (1984), after a year he was transferred to 2 PPCLI in Germany, and Winnipeg, MB,

After serving with the PPCLI for 9 + years, he received his Voluntary Occupational Transfer to become a Construction Engineer. In Dec 1992 CWO Rochlow was posted to Royal Canadian School of Military Engineering (RCSME) Chilliwack, BC, where he attended his QL3 Construction Tech course. Upon completion of training he was posted to CFB Borden, ON, where he spent the next 8 years completing his OJT, PLQ, and QL 5. His next posting took him to 4 Engineer Support Regiment, Construction Troop in Petawawa, where he was attached to 2 Combat Engineer Regiment (2 CER).

During his tenure with 2 CER CWO Rochlow held various positions within the Construction Troop from (Sect Commander – Troop Warrant Officer) and deployed on various assignments overseas.

After 6 years with 2 CER, he was once again on the move, this time further East to take up employment with 1 Engineer Support Unit, in Moncton NB, during his time there he was employed as a Construction Tech within a Specialized Engineer Team, and as Troop Warrant Officer of the Specialists within the Design and Surveyor teams, as well he was employed as the OPS WO and took care of all the pers deploying for overseas taskings, as well he was deployed on a few of his own missions overseas, and Canada.

CWO Rochlow was promoted to MWO in 2011, and posted to CFB North Bay, ON, he assumed the role of Base Construction Engineer Sqn SSM, during his time in North Bay he assumed positions of Wing Administrative CWO, and Base CWO, during their absences, he also ensured the every day workings of the base were kept in good order.

After completing 4 years in North Bay, CWO Rochlow's next posting he was appointed as the Detachment Commander for CFS Letrim, DET Masset, during his 2 years there he maintained the morale and discipline of the troops, and ensured the maintenance of the infrastructure was taken care of.

CWO Rochlow retired from the Reg Force in 2017 with 34 years of experience under his belt, at which time he moved to Vancouver BC to be closer to his family and future wife.

CWO Rochlow Joined the primary reserves, and his first unit he served with was the British Columbia Regiment, he served as their Training Sqn SSM.

After a short stay with the BCR's he was appointed as RSM Apr 2018 with 39 CBT Engineer Regiment in Chilliwack, He was promoted to his current rank 02 June 2018.
