They came, they saw, they blew up. International, regular and reserve forces from North Vancouver, Trail, Chilliwack, Calgary, Edmonton, Manitoba, Everett, Washington and London, England demolished the old Phillips Bridge six km north of the existing bridge over the Elk River using 400 pounds of Forecite explosives. The bridge had been closed since the early '50s. The concussion from the blast, which occurred at 10:10 am on Thursday, August 29th, moved an armored personnel carrier half a foot. -photos by Dave Brown
